

Seder Dinner & The Lord's Supper

April 1, 2010

All are invited for an evening of remembrance and reflection this Holy Week as we share together a **Seder Meal on Maundy Thursday April 1, 2010 at Our Savior**. On the night that Jesus was betrayed, He gathered with his disciples in an upper room to share together with them one last Passover here on earth. The Passover meal that they shared together called them to remember the events of the Exodus as they would every year -- only this time Jesus concluded the meal with a new blessing for His followers by instituting the Sacrament of Holy Communion. This year at Our Savior we will spend time together on the evening of April 1st experiencing together a taste of what that Passover would have been like through a Christian Seder Dinner.

What to expect: We will begin the evening with the Seder Passover experience by guiding you through the eating of special foods and dialogue connected with it. This part of the experience is a **hands-on experience for children and adults of all ages** as we connect the Biblical narrative to the activity of eating and drinking. After this experience we will provide a **larger special dinner that will include foods for both adults and kids in a buffet style**. After each seating of the Seder Meal and Dinner we will offer a time of **confession and absolution followed by Holy Communion in the Sanctuary**. The evening will conclude with a time of personal reflection as we prepare our hearts and minds for Good Friday.

In order to accommodate the largest number of people, and to help keep an intimate atmosphere, we are offering two different seating times of **5:30 pm and 7:00 pm and are requesting reservations**. We ask for a free will donation of \$5 per adult for the meal and \$3 for kids to help us cover some of the costs; but do not let money become an issue for coming—even if you can't make a donation at this time, you are welcome to join us.

We truly hope this Seder Experience will help people of all ages connect the promise of the Messiah in the Old Testament with the fulfillment in the passion of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. Contact Pastor Nathan or the church office with any questions. Shalom!
